St. Vrain Valley Schools' Induction Program is committed to accelerating the professional growth of educators and positively impacting student achievement. The guiding principles of continuous improvement, collegiality and reflection support the growth of educators in St. Vrain.

Upon submission of evidence of completion for the following assignments, state and district requirements for induction will be satisfied. The Office of Professional Development will then issue you a certificate that may be used for state licensure purposes. You will also receive 1.0 professional development/salary credit for completing all of the induction requirements. Attendance at **New Teacher Orientation**

Completion of a Coaching and Consultation Cycle

Novice and experienced interventionists will complete a coaching and consultation cycle with their assigned mentor. This cycle will include individual and small group meetings. Novice Interventionists (those with less than 3 years of experience) will log a minimum of 24 hours of individual and small group meeting time. Experienced Interventionists (those with 3 or more years of experience) should log a minimum of 8 hours. These logs should be submitted at the end of the year (see the box below), showing meeting dates, times and focus areas. Your mentor will verify completion of induction.
